- Cultivated a positive learning environment where kids and young adults could thrive and learn theater skills
- Ended each camp with a talent show performance to showcase what the students learned during the camp duration

Pennsylvania Shakespeare Festival

- Choreographed stage combat training for other actors as well as run instructional classes/ demonstrations for students
- Traveled to high schools throughout all of Pennsylvania to help educate students on performing arts techniques

- President of the UArts Improv team; held auditions + ran weekly rehearsals to prepare for the 6 shows per semester
- Created a four-1 act comedy festival that was completely student run and organized; has since been implemented into the casting season at UArts
